Founder, Executive Director & President of the Unity Network

- Founded a 501c3 non-profit organization called the Community Life Network, Inc. (CLN) as an umbrella organization that is the centerpiece of the Unity Network. The CLN supports a variety of projects that help solve problems of the 21st Century with principles rooted in global justice, sustainability, and grassroots activism.
- As the Executive Director my role included:
 - Legal, Finance, and Budgets: Within the Non-profit there is about \$20,000 annual budget with annual filing and budget processes.
 - Websites, Social Media and Digital Design: Developed dozens of project and program websites, social media campaigns, and design logos and flyers.
 - Grant Writing: Helped write a variety of grants, some of which were funded, with a grand total of about \$50,000 of grants into the network over the last 5 years.
- Over the last 2-3 years, the primary focus of the network has been developing proposals for economic systems based on natural ecology and sustainability. By collaborating with a variety of non-profits and community organizations including Inspired Legacies, and Occupy during 2011, I have helped make significant strides within today's largest movement and primary focus of the Unity Network.
- Other projects include Digital Storytellers, which teaches slam poetry and digital editing skills to at risk youth in Oakland and Richmond; and Hemp Education Project, which educates the public on transforming our economy using industrialized hemp.
